

# BROADWAY BOUND CHILDREN'S THEATRE

## 2011 SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Criteria for eligibility:

- The Executive Director will review all scholarship applications, and eligibility determinations will be final.
- If accepted for a scholarship, either full or half, Broadway Bound requires each scholarship family to contribute 15 hours of volunteer time.
- If the student in question is eligible for the federal free or reduced lunch program, they automatically qualify for a full scholarship upon submission of a supporting letter.
- Otherwise, the family shall submit proof of income. Household income shall be based on Line 35 of form 1040 (adjusted gross income) or the equivalent on 1040a or 1040ez.
  - Application date of January 1 through June 30: Applicant shall submit their tax return for the previous year.
  - Application date of July 1 through December 31: Applicant shall submit their tax return for the previous year as well as a signed estimate of current year earnings, back up with copies of their most recent pay stubs. The two years' income shall be averaged for the purposes of determining eligibility.

- **Full Scholarship Thresholds:** For a full scholarship, household income cannot exceed the following.

- **Partial Scholarship Thresholds:** For a half scholarship household income cannot exceed 150% of full scholarship thresholds.

Family size	Annual income
2	\$40,821
3	\$51,422
4	\$62,022
5	\$72,623
6	\$82,223
7	\$93,824

- Families who do not meet the above income criteria, but whom have extenuating circumstances and wish to apply for financial assistance, should direct a letter to the Executive Director detailing those circumstances.
